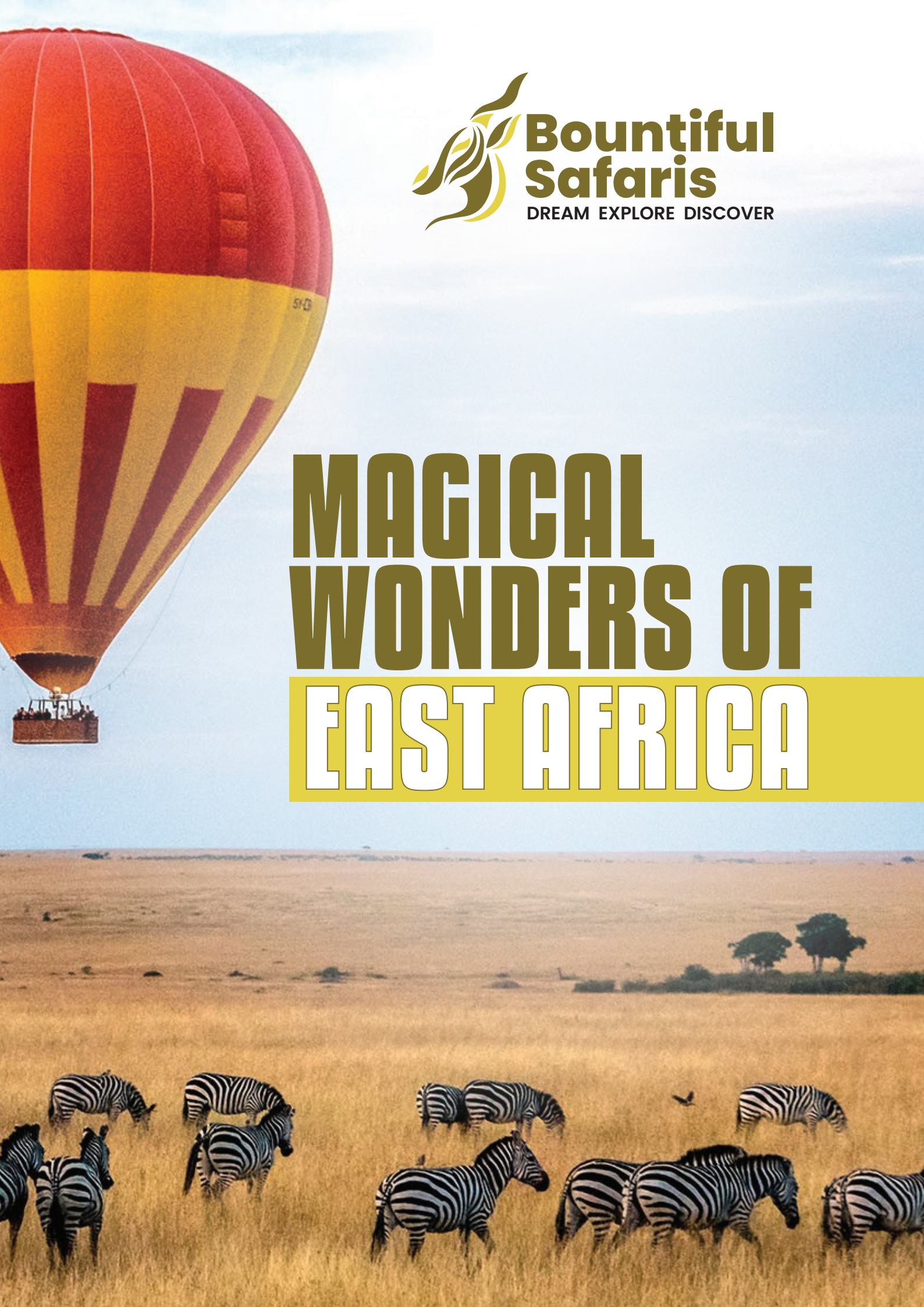

15 DAYS 14 NIGHTS COMBINED BEACH & BUSH

DESCRIPTION

This 15-day exciting safari will give you an opportunity to visit Kenya's best national parks with popular game-viewing activities. You will be able to easily spot the Big Five as well as numerous plain games. You will visit the Ol Pejeta Conservancy. This is the only park in Kenya where you can see chimpanzees. In Samburu, you will meet the special five before heading to Lake Nakuru for the flamingos and to the wildlife jewel of Mara Amboseli home of African elephants and the magnificent beaches of the Kenyan coast.

PROPOSED ITINERARY

Day 1: Jomo Kenyatta International Airport – Nairobi hotel

Upon your arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi, you will be met by our driver guide, and kick start your journey to Samburu. You will arrive in time for check in and lunch before departing for your first game viewing drive in search for wildlife to the park. Later on, return to your lodge for dinner and your overnight stay.

Day 2: Explore Samburu National Reserve

Enjoy your breakfast followed by a full day of unlimited wildlife viewing. Possible sightings include the Special Five of Samburu; the reticulated giraffe, the Grevy zebra, the Beisa oryx, the Somali ostrich, and gerenuk, all rare species that occur only in this part of the country, and look for its well-known larger game including elephants, lions and leopards. Enjoy a picnic lunch before heading back to the camp to relax for the afternoon/evening. Your game drives will be along the Ewaso Nyiro River where most of the wild animals are found. Dinner and overnight will be at the camp.

Day 3: Samburu - Ol Pejeta Conservancy

You will be picked up from your hotel in the morning and driven through central Kenya to the lower slopes of Mount Kenya to Ol Pejeta conservancy, arriving at the camp in time for lunch. In the afternoon, have a game drive in this private sanctuary, with a visit to the Chimpanzee Sanctuary, the only one of its kind in Kenya. You will also visit the Visitors Information Centre. The conservancy is a host of the big five. Boasts the largest black rhino sanctuary in East Africa and houses two of the remaining Northern white rhino in the world. Return to the camp for dinner and your overnight stay.

Day 4: Ol Pejeta Conservancy to Nakuru

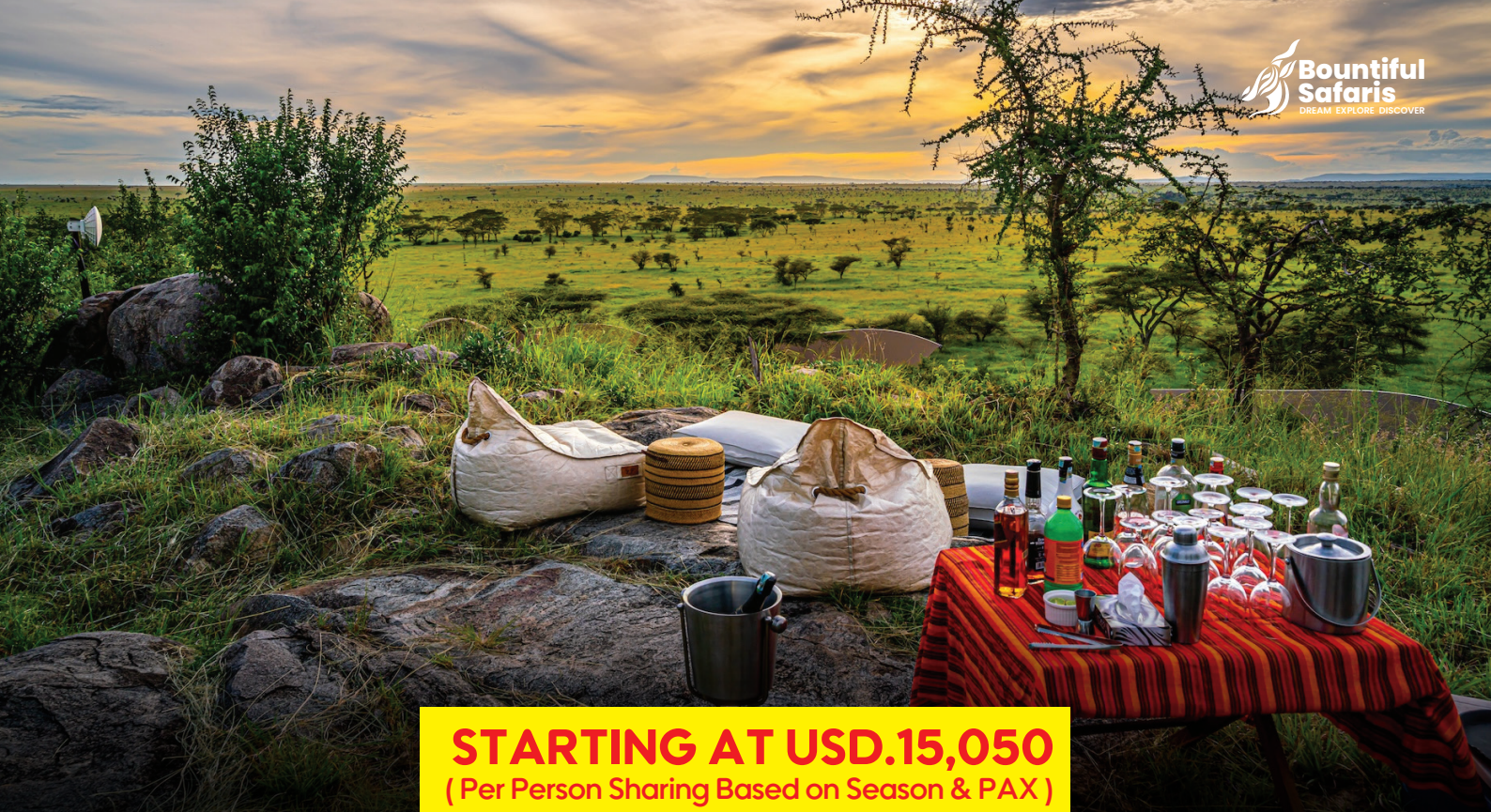
After breakfast you will depart for Nakuru National Park. You will arrive in time for lunch and an afternoon game drive. Here you will spend a delightful day exploring the extraordinary birdlife for which Lake Nakuru is internationally renowned. This is the ultimate ornithologist's paradise with over 450 species of birds. Apart from its thousands and sometimes millions of flamingos nesting along the shores, the surface of the shallow lake is often hard to recognize due to the continually shifting mass of pink. The number of flamingos on the lake varies with water and food conditions and the best vantage point is from Baboon Cliff. Dinner and your overnight stay are at the lodge.

Day 5: Lake Nakuru National Park – Masai Mara National Reserve

Enjoy breakfast, check out, and depart for Masai Mara National Reserve with a game enroute. Arrive in time for check in followed by lunch and a short time to relax before embarking on an afternoon game drive. After enjoying your afternoon Kenyan tea and coffee, head out for an exciting game-viewing adventure. Search some of the area's wildlife hotspots determined by your driver guide as they've learned and understand the game's daily routines through tracking. During the game drive you will be able to see a wide range of wildlife including zebras, wildebeests, gazelles, lions, cheetahs, leopards, and African wild dogs among others. Later return to the camp for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 6: Explore Masai Mara National Reserve

Enjoy your breakfast and head to the reserve for a full-day game drive with your packed lunch. On this day you will explore the endless plains of the reserve on a full-day game drive. The reserve is well known for its black-manned lions, as well as its abundant resident wildlife. It's one of the few places where it's possible to see the Big Five during a morning game drive. Many of the cheetahs are so tame that they seek shelter from the hot sun under one's vehicle and several even climb onto the roof to get a better view of prospective prey. The Mara River is the gateway of the annual migration of wildebeest from Serengeti to Masai Mara. This great spectacle features the pounding of over 6 million hooves from the vast Serengeti plains to the champagne colored hills of Kenya's Masai Mara where over 1 million wildebeest, 300,000 gazelle, and some

DAY 7: MARA - AMBOSELI

DAY 9: AMBOSELI TSAVO

After breakfast you check out of the lodge and proceed to Tsavo, Using a private Land Cruiser where you will arrive in time for Lunch. Have your Lunch, freshen up a little bit and Later on head for and Afternoon game drive at Tsavo and Finally dinner and overnight at Finch Hattons.

DAY 10: FULL DAY TSAVO

From the sight of fifty million gallons of crystal clear water gushing out of the under parched lava rock that is the Mzima Springs to the Shetani lava flows, Tsavo West is a beautiful, rugged wilderness. The savannah ecosystem comprises open grasslands, scrublands, and Acacia woodlands, belts of riverine vegetation and rocky ridges including the Poacher's Lookout where visitors can see the teeming herds in the plains below. Tsavo West offers some of the most magnificent game viewing in the world and attractions include elephant, rhino, Hippos, lions, cheetah, leopards, Buffalos, diverse plant and bird species including the threatened corncrake and near threatened Basra Reed Warbler.

DAY 11: TSAVO- DIANI

After Breakfast, have a game drive enroute on your way to the Airstrip for your flight direct to ukunda using Mombasa Air. Arrive in time for Lunch, where after check in, you get to enjoy the famous Diani Beach.

DAY 12-14 DIANI BEACH

Get to enjoy the sparkling white sands and lush greenery of Diani for you to relax under a beach umbrella with a refreshing drink. Try a camel ride for the tourist experience or book a bike tour inland for a glimpse of life in local villages.

PROPOSED ITINERARY

DAY 1: ARRIVAL AT JKIA

Touch Down Nairobi Kenya, and be transferred to Hemingways hotel in Nairobi as you enjoy the beautiful views of the skyscrapers in Nairobi Kenya. Spend your Overnight at Hemingways Nairobi.

DAY 2: NAIROBI TO LEWA CONSERVANCY

WHERE WILD MEETS WONDERS: DISCOVER KENYA & TANZANIA IN 10 UNFORGETTABLE NIGHTS

PROPOSED ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrive In Nairobi

On arrival at JKIA international Airport, you will be met by a bountiful safaris representative and get transferred to your City Hotel. Based on the arrival time of your international flight, you can spend time at leisure or opt to have a brief visit to Nairobi safari walk, the Karen Blixen or even a meal at the Famous carnivore restaurant.

Overnight at the hotel.

Day 2: Nairobi/Amboseli

At around 7 am we will pick up from your Nairobi hotel and drive south to Amboseli via Emali, arriving in time for lunch. After lunch proceed to the park for another game drive. The plains offer numerous jackals, spotted hyenas, olive baboons, vervet monkeys, antelopes and the chance of spotting leopards or cheetahs. On the Observation hill there is a conical peak which is easy to climb and offers great views of Mount Kilimanjaro. You may also have an optional visit to authentic Masai village at an extra cost. Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

Day 3: Amboseli/Namanga/Arusha

An Early morning Breakfast at your Hotel. Check-out and enjoy an en-route Game drive before proceeding to Namanga which is the Kenya / Tanzania border. Clear with the customs and immigration, change vehicles and hop on the Tanzania safari vehicles and continue on your journey to Arusha, Tanzania. Check-in for lunch at your Arusha hotel. Later in the afternoon, take your time to discover the beauty of Arusha city from Clock tower (the half way between Cairo Egypt to Johannesburg South Africa) and take walking to Maasai Market, proceed to Arusha Declaration monument and museum, central market to learn different African spices, vegetable and fruits, visit Arusha City bus terminal, then later drive to Cultural Heritage Centre for shopping and visit Snake park and Maasai boma at the same place (option to visit snake park) after enjoying different kinds of snake, birds, crocodiles, tortoise etc. we will drive you back to your hotel

Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

Day 4: Arusha/ Lake Manyara

After breakfast, check out and drive to the Lake Manyara region arriving in perfect time for lunch at the hotel. Afterwards, enjoy a rewarding game drive at Lake Manyara National Park in the afternoon. This is a park well known for hundreds of bird species. Between November and April, thousands of greater and lesser pink flamingos gather on its shores, along with pink-backed pelicans, yellow-billed storks, grey herons and pods of hippo. Surrounding the lake are grassy plains and acacia woodlands, home to tree-climbing lions and long-tusked elephants. Giraffe's, buffalos, zebras & wildebeest can be visibly seen along the grasslands where they graze. While at it, you can visit the Maji Moto hot springs to soak in the warm, clear water under the shade of leafy trees. Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

Day 5: Lake Manyara/Ngorongoro

After breakfast, enjoy some time off relaxing before departing to Karatu. Visit the local Iraqw Village followed by lunch and a guided Coffee Plantation Tour. Afterwards, depart for Ngorongoro. Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

Day 6: Ngorongoro

After breakfast depart for a full day game drive within the Ngorongoro Crater area. Stop for picnic lunch. Return at your Lodge late in the afternoon. Ngorongoro conservation area is a well-known UNESCO protected area connecting to the Serengeti in the north-west and to the Great Rift Valley in the east. The park was established as a conservation area for wildlife and the semi-nomadic Maasai population that reside in it. The caldera is an important landmark for human history, as well as an essential habitat safeguarding animal diversity. Despite its small area, the caldera has excellent biodiversity, and several globally threatened species live on these plains. These plains form part of the route of the Great Migration. Aside from the main caldera, there are two other volcanic craters: the Olmoti and Empakai. The Olmoti is famed for its beautiful waterfalls, and the Empakai is known for its deep lake and lush green walls. Dinner and overnight at your hotel

Day 7: Ngorongoro/Serengeti

After breakfast check out and drive towards Serengeti. Visit an authentic Masai village and another amazing site which is the Olduvai Gorge, a 14km long ravine. In order to protect this incredible natural wonder, visitor numbers are closely monitored, and you must obtain a permit to enter the crater and the gorge whilst en-route to Serengeti. Later enjoy the first game drive in Serengeti. Arrive in the afternoon for a late lunch. Afterwards, partake in a refreshing afternoon game drive. Dinner and overnight at your camp.



Day 8: Serengeti

Explore the Wildebeest Migration. On your Full Day Serengeti North Game Drive, the Lobo Hills are covered in large acacia trees which support large amounts of elephants, giraffes, antelopes, buffaloes, and the carnivores that prey on them. It's a fascinating opportunity to see a large number of Africa's most iconic animals in a relatively small amount of time. From here, we'll proceed to the Bologonja and Wogatende areas where we will eventually meet the Mara River itself. Home to large numbers of hippos and Nile crocodiles. The Mara River is the last major obstacle standing between the Wildebeest Migration and the relative safety of the Masai Mara. If you're patient and a little lucky, you may even get to witness the death-defying crossing itself where wildebeest and zebras brave the river's currents and crocodiles in an attempt to reach safety on the opposite bank.

Day 9: Serengeti/Tarime/Migori/Masai Mara

After breakfast at the lodge, check out and drive to the airstrip for a scheduled flight to Tarime Airstrip. Afterwards, transfer by road to the border for Immigration procedure. Continue by road to Migori Airstrip for a scheduled flight to the Masai Mara. Arrive around lunch time. Upon arrival at the airstrip, your camp guide will be waiting to take you to your hotel. After lunch, enjoy an afternoon game drive through Masai Mara. Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

Day 10: Masai Mara

Full day is spent exploring the park in search of the big five. The Mara offers wildlife in such a great variety and abundance that is truly difficult to believe. Over 450 species of animals have been recorded here, you will easily see rhinos, leopard, elephants, buffalo, wildebeests, zebra, warthog, Jackals, lions, many types of antelopes, crocodiles and giraffe. Although July, August and September are the months when the Mara plains are filled with migrating wildebeest and zebra from Serengeti (Tanzania). The famous Maasai tribesmen live within the dispersal area of the game reserve, Picnic lunch is served in the park. In the evening return to the lodge. Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

Day 11: Masai Mara/Nairobi/Departure

Breakfast at your Lodge. Enjoy a final shared game drive en-route to the airstrip. Scheduled flight to Nairobi Wilson airport. Welcome on arrival and lunch at Carnivore Restaurant in Nairobi. Drop off at JKIA Airport in the afternoon for your scheduled flight back home

BOUNTIFUL SAFARIS 7 DAY'S MACHAME OUT MWEKA / TUSKER ROUTE

TOUR DESCRIPTION

The Machame route is arguably the most scenic and probably the most beautiful route by which to ascend the mighty Mount Kilimanjaro. The trek begins in the south-west area of the mountain at Machame Gate and descends down Mweka, on the south-east side of the mountain thus offering climbers the most varied scenery of Kilimanjaro. Additionally, Machame visits stunning places such as Shira Plateau, Barranco, and Lava Tower. Machame route is known as the "Whiskey Route" in comparison to Marangu because it is a more difficult route and trekkers sleep in camping tents as opposed to huts. Machame is the second most popular route on the mountain.

Nights are spent in 'mountain tents' sleeping two persons per tent (3 man tents, so there is space for your luggage). All your supplies and camping equipment are carried by porters and your meals are prepared. Machame is ideal for those who want a more difficult climb, and are confident in their ability to hike for long periods of time over somewhat steep terrain. The route takes six days minimum to complete, although seven days is recommended to increase the chances of summiting. The descent is down Mweka, on the south-east side of the mountain.

Itinerary:

Day 1: Nairobi - Moshi

leave Nairobi at 7:30am drive through Namanga border check in then proceed to Arusha further to Moshi for Overnight in a hotel. 8hrs drive

Day 2: Moshi - Machame hut (9,840ft/3000m)

Drive to the Kilimanjaro National Park gate entry registration. Start the trek to Machame hut through thick rainforest. Have packed lunch on the way. Dinner and retire for the day.

Day 3: Machame hut - Shira hut (12,470ft/3800m)

Ascend to Shira Hut past the Shira plateau and through ridges and valleys. Stay here overnight.

Day 4: Shira hut - Barranco camp (12,960ft/3950m)

Head eastward to a junction where we continue to Lava Tower Campsite (14,760ft/4500m), then descend to Barranco camp thus allowing your body to adjust to altitude change. Take the day's rest here.

Day 5: Barranco camp - Barafu camp (15,090ft/4600m)

Across the Karanga Valley and ascend to Barafu campsite. Have dinner and take the day's rest ready for the hike to the summit.

Note: An extra day for acclimatization can be added by staying overnight at Karanga camp then proceeding to Barafu camp the next day..

Day 6: Barafu Camp-Summit(19,340 ft/5895m)-Mweka

5 DAY'S MT KENYA HIKE SIRIMON DOWN CHOGORIA ROUTE ITINERARY

Itinerary

Day 1:

Nairobi - Sirimon gate - Old Moses camp. (3,300m)
After pick up in Nairobi, drive to Nanyuki town crossing the equator en route, further to the Sirimon Park gate (2660m) picnic as your guide signs in the park. From the gate, we trek up through magnificent montane forest, bamboo and giant heather zone before reaching the high altitude moorland and our first hut (Old Moses camp 3,300m) for dinner and overnight. This is a gentle trek that takes 3 - 4 hrs gaining an elevation of 680m.

Day 2:

Old Moses - Shipton camp (4200m).
After breakfast, follow the track uphill, forking right at the junction. After a water break, you continue on the track crossing Ontulili River before turning right contouring through the Moorland and crossing Liki North River and continue uphill to Mackinders Valley from where there are panoramic views up the valley towards the Shipton Camp. This camp is a surreal setting below the towering peaks and glaciers. Resident population is Rock hyrax and sun birds.

Day 3:

Shiptons camp (4200m) - Oblong and Hamburgers tarns (4600m)
Full Day Acclimatization
For better acclimatization you can take a rest day at the Shipton camp. Short walks / day hikes are possible on the summit climb to Oblong and Hausberg tarns, gaining an elevation of 400m before returning to the camp for lunch. Afternoon is at leisure.
N.B:
Climbing high and sleeping low is excellent for acclimatization – but you can do that almost as well touching in the sun watching the eagles!

Day 4:

Shipton - Pt Lenana (4985m)- Mt Kenya Bandas (2800m)
Kick off at 3.am to reach pt Lenana in time for the African sunrise. The climb starts on a frozen screen and continues on a rocky track with some very minor scrambling. With a good Moon you barely need a torch. Without a Moon, then the pollution - free sky bangs on the ground giving you as good a view of the stars as almost anywhere on Earth. The climb takes 3 -4 hrs and to add to the exhilaration, Mt. Kilimanjaro is also visible from the horizon. Descend to Minto's hut for full breakfast. After a short rest descend further to Mt Kenya bandas along the gorges valley where you can enjoy good views of The Temple, Lake Michaelson, Mushroom rocks and Giant billiards table. Dinner and overnight at the Bandas. You can enjoy log fires, hot showers and bed at the Bandas!

Day 5:

Chogoria Bandas - Chogoria town - Nairobi.
After breakfast, depending on how you will be feeling there are 2 options, either the vehicle to pick you up from Chogoria Bandas or descend on a broad track through bamboo and virgin rainforest for 10 km to meet vehicle for transfer to Chogoria town and further to Nairobi arriving by 17:00 hr
